What is Hospice?

Hospice care is a special kind of care focusing on the quality of life for people and their caregivers experiencing advanced, life-limiting illness. The goal is to provide spiritual, emotional and social support for hospice patients and their families improving quality of life for everyone. Hospice of VVRMC can help you make well-informed decisions when faced with a difficult situation.

Hospice provides services wherever a patient calls home by making regular visits to assess the patient needs, supportive care, symptom management, or comfort care. Patients and their families have access to an entire team of hospice professionals who provide the highest quality of compassionate care.

When to Refer?

When a person is coping with a life limiting illness diagnosis, it can be difficult to find the right kind of care and support. Too often, the quality of life declines as treatments and side effects worsen.

Are you or a loved one:

- Repeatedly visiting the emergency room?
- Contacting your primary physician for matters related to symptom management?
- Repeatedly being admitted to the hospital, ICU or being transferred for specialty care?
- Experiencing difficulty with pain management?

Hospice is for patients with serious illnesses. Through Hospice of VVRMC, patient receive symptom relief and all the support they need to have the highest quality of life possible.

Patient Eligibility:

- Must have a life limiting diagnosis
- Patient/family must select hospice care with the ultimate goal being symptom relief and a focus on quality of life
- Must have an able and willing 24 hour caregiver
